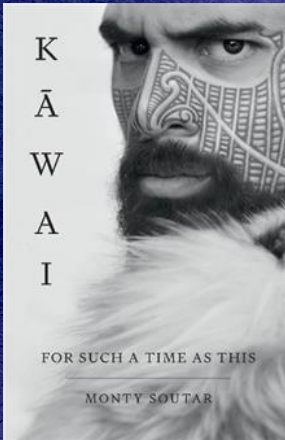


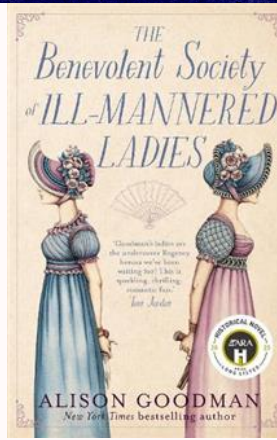

The story was really captivating & even though it is a work of fiction I learnt a lot about pre-colonial Maori culture.

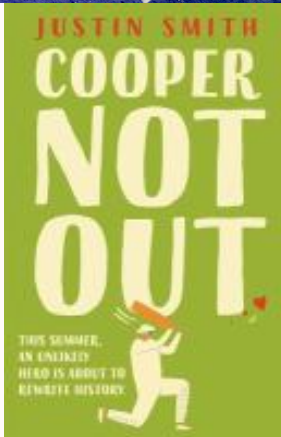

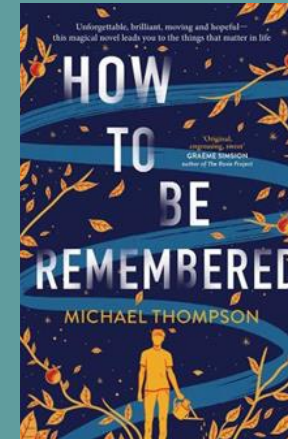
DAL

I really enjoyed the quirky character Molly. It is a reminder that we all view the world differently.

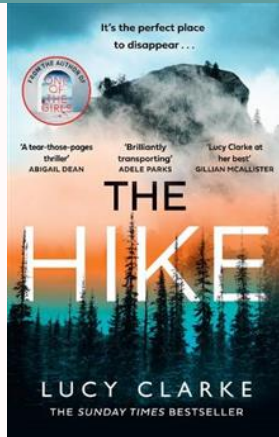


THO

A fun, fresh take on the 'Superhero' genre that made me smile. I love a book with a fresh, unusual storyline and this book delivered.



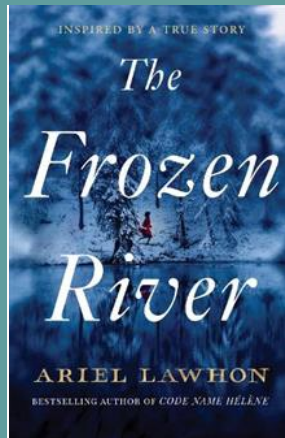
COL
